BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Minutes of Meeting July 12, 2016

The Board of Morgan County Commissioners met on July 12, 2016 at 9:15 a.m. with Chairman Pro Tem Brian McCracken and Commissioner James Zwetzig in attendance with Chair Laura Teague absent. Chairman Pro Tem McCracken called the meeting to order and asked Morgan County Treasurer Bob Sagel to lead the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Commissioner Zwetzig made a motion to approve all items on the Consent Agenda as presented. Chairman Pro Tem McCracken seconded the motion and the motion carried 2-0.

GENERAL BUSINESS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Consideration of Approval – GRANT 2016 GRA 010 – Title IV-E Waiver Demonstration Project

Morgan County Department of Human Services Director Jacque Frenier presented to the Board for approval, a Grant 2016 GRA 010 for Title IV-E Waiver Demonstration Project in the amount of \$41,028.00. Ms. Frenier stated the IV-E is referred to federal funds that provide funding for the foster care facilities and this waiver allows the department to keep children in their own homes or with family members. The Federal Government has allowed states to pilot whether or not the IV-E funding can be used in a better way than out of home placement. The State of Colorado allows counties to apply for this funding and she explained that these funds were utilized last year and they are funding kinship homes which allow children to remain in family homes rather than be placed out of home in foster care.

Commissioner Zwetzig made a motion to approve 2016 GRA 010 Title IV-E Waiver Demonstration Project Grant as presented by Morgan County Department of Human Services Director Jacque Frenier in the total amount of \$41,028.00 and authorized Chair Teague's signature. Chairman Pro Tem McCracken seconded the motion and the motion carried 2-0.

COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Morgan County Treasurer and Public Trustee Bob Sagel presented to the Board the Morgan County Treasurer's Second Quarter Report for 2016. Mr. Sagel provided summarized the percentage of collected taxes were down this time from last year. He stated that treasurer fees earned was up from this time last year by 11.05 percent. He further summarized the total investments, reserve accounts and stated that interest earned actually doubled from this time last year. Mr. Sagel then summarized the foreclosure events indicating that new files have increased by 21.21 percent and that the release of deeds of trusts has decreased by 8.25 percent. He stated he believes that everything is going in the direction the County would like to see it go.

Commissioner Zwetzig made a motion to approve Morgan County Treasurer's report as submitted by Treasurer and Public Trustee Bob Sagel. Chairman Pro Tem McCracken seconded the motion and motion carried 2-0.

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated July 8, 2016, through July 19, 2016 with no changes.

Commissioner Zwetzig stated there will be a FEMA presentation this evening regarding the flood plain and invited citizens to attend. He outlined the structure of the floodplain program and stated this evening FEMA will be presenting their preliminary floodplain map which changes the boundaries of the mapping. The County has chosen to notify as many citizens using the County's mapping system of those who may be affected. Commissioner Zwetzig stated the majority of changes will take place on the eastern side of Morgan County but there will be some changes along the areas of the South Platte River overall. He stressed this is a critical meeting for the citizens of Morgan County to voice their opinions and the meeting will begin at 4:00 p.m. this evening at the Morgan County Fairgrounds. This change in mapping will require landowners to carry flood insurance.

Commissioner Zwetzig announced there will be a Broadband Plan presentation held at the Morgan County Administration Building on July 18, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. in which all elected officials, businesses, and others in the public have been invited to attend. This meeting is also open to the public to attend.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

There was no citizen's comment.

PUBLIC HEARING

Application for a Conditional Use Permit to place a new church building on the property they own located in Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, aka 14851 Hwy 34, Fort Morgan, CO 80701

The hearing was called to order by Chairman Pro Tem McCracken at 9:30 a.m. in the Assembly Room of the Morgan County Administration Building. Present were Chairman Pro Tem Brian McCracken and Commissioner James Zwetzig in attendance with Chair Laura Teague absent. Also present were John Crosthwait, Planning Administrator and Iglesia de Cristo Nuevo Amanecer, the applicant.

**APPLICANT: IGLESIA DECRISTO NUEVO AMANECER
LANDOWNERS: IGLESIA DECRISTO NUEVO AMANECER**

Chairman Pro Tem McCracken asked Morgan County Planning Administrator John Crosthwait to present the file and invited the applicants to the front. Mr. Crosthwait presented the file noting the applicants have submitted an application for a Conditional Use Permit to place a new church building on the property they own located in Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, aka 14851 Hwy 34, Fort Morgan, CO 80701.

Planning Administrator John Crosthwait presented an Application for a Conditional Use Permit to place a new church building on the property they own located in Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, aka 14851 Hwy 34, Fort Morgan, CO 80701.

Mr. Crosthwait stated the applicant is requesting to build a new church for their congregation located on Lot 2 of the Sanctuary Minor Subdivision, located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, aka 14851, Hwy 34, fort Morgan, Colorado. Presently, the congregation of approximately 70 resides in a small building in Log Lane Village, which has inadequate seating, parking, and is in very poor repair. The present location has no room for expansion. Iglesia DeCristo Nuevo Amanecer is a sister Latino congregation of the Sanctuary, and was sold the land, complete with a Morgan County Quality Water Tap. Access has been granted via an easement through the Sanctuary property, and Colorado Department of Transportation has agreed with the joint use of the existing driveway. A site plan and a conceptional picture of the proposed church building is included in the file. He stated that all appropriate fees, notices and publications have been met. Property is zoned "C" Commercial. Property is not located in the floodplain. Property is served by Morgan County Quality Water District Tap #2876. A "Will Serve" letter from the Northeast Colorado Health department is included in the file. At this time Mr. Crosthwait recommended approval of the Conditional Use Permit for the new church building.

At this time, representatives for the applicant Iglesia DeCristo Nuevo Amanecer, Carlos Moya, stated his address as 126 Eldorado, Fort Morgan, Colorado. He stated they wish to make a big impact on the Latino community in Morgan County and requests approval of this application. He spoke of the Pastor who has a love for this community and his desire to help the community through this project.

Chairman Pro Tem McCracken opened the matter for public comment in which Paul Sanchez, 431 Elm Street, Fort Morgan, Colorado stated he is with the Sanctuary Church and stated he is in favor of this project, and stated this has been the vision of the church when it the property was purchased. At this time, Chairman Pro Tem the moved to discussion and decision.

Commissioner Zwetzig asked about the minor subdivision being a two lot subdivision asking Mr. Crosthwait to point out which is lot 2 with Mr. Crosthwait doing so. Commissioner Zwetzig asked if the access easement which is reflected on the subdivision map as being conveyed on the deed. At this time the deed was reviewed and this was confirmed with Commissioner Zwetzig asking that the applicants understand this is an easement only and the County will not be maintaining this roadway with Mr. Moya expressing he understood.

Chairman McCracken asked if the church will look like what is being presented today in their packet with Mr. Moya stating "pretty close".

Commissioner Zwetzig asked about required covenants on all new subdivisions, with Mr. Crosthwait stating they do not require covenants and there are no covenants being required for this subdivision. Mr. Crosthwait stated the only item indicated on the deed would be transpired between the Sanctuary and this applicant. Commissioner Zwetzig mentioned the verbiage regarding the grantor has the first right of refusal clause and asked about how this is being construed. He clarified this permit is only for the applicant if this defaults back to the grantor. He asked that this be understood on the record.

Commissioner Zwetzig asked how CDOT is going to determine whether or not a different access will be required given traffic volume. Mr. Crosthwait stated this will be determined between CDOT and the property owners. Commissioner Zwetzig stressed that he does not want this to be brought back to the County to be the enforcer for the determination of this matter and that it is only between the property owner and CDOT. Further comment was made that if there is a twenty percent increase in traffic that the determination is solely between CDOT and the property

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owner. Mr. Crosthwait stated the applicant has retained an individual who will provide for all the required parking, handicap accessibility and design standards to meet the County requirements. Commissioner Zwetzig asked if the County should be satisfied that the present accessibility as to traffic flow is sufficient for 300 people with Mr. Crosthwait stating it is sufficient.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Zwetzig to approve Resolution 2016 BCC 017 Granting a Conditional Use Permit to place a new church building on the property they own located in Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, aka 14851 Hwy 34, Fort Morgan, CO 80701 as requested by Iglesia de Cristo Nuevo Amanecer. Chairman Pro Tem McCracken seconded the motion and motion carried 2-0.

RESOLUTION 2016 BCC 17

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing pursuant to the Morgan County Zoning and Subdivision Regulations on the application of Iglesia DeCristo Nuevo Amanecer as applicant and landowner for a Conditional Use Permit to establish a new Church building for their congregation. The parcel is located in Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, also known as 14851 Highway 34, Fort Morgan, Colorado 80701.

WHEREAS, the notice of the public hearing was properly posted and published, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from the applicant, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and comments from the public, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and comments from the Morgan County Planning Administrator who recommended approval of the application, and

WHEREAS, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended approval of the application.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO

1. The application of Iglesia DeCristo Nuevo Amanecer as applicant and landowner for a Conditional Use Permit to establish a new church building for their congregation located on Lot 2, Sanctuary Minor Subdivision located in the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan county, Colorado, also known as 14851 Hwy 34, fort Morgan, Colorado is hereby granted.
2. The location shall be as indicated specifically on the application.
3. 3. The permit is in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan.
4. All applicable design standards have been met. The Morgan County Commissioners retain continuing jurisdiction on this permit to address the possibility of any future problems with this site and to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
5. The Conditional Use Permit has been made compatible with the surrounding uses.
6. The Church structure shall be constructed in accordance with the applicable building standards and code as adopted by the Morgan County Planning and Zoning Department.
7. Access to the property has been granted by the Colorado Department of Transportation. In the event the increased use of the existing access increases beyond twenty percent (20%) of the existing use, the owners of the property shall obtain a revised and approved permit from the Colorado Department of Transportation.
8. It is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to grant this permit.
9. The applicant shall be responsible for complying with all the foregoing requirements and design standards. Noncompliance with any of the foregoing requirements or design standards may be reason for revocation of this permit by the Board of Morgan County Commissioners.
10. All interior road construction and maintenance shall be the responsibility of the landowners, and not that of Morgan County. Any future drainage issues shall be the responsibility of the landowners, and not that of Morgan County.
